## 1. CALL TO ORDER AND PLEDGE TO THE FLAG

Vice-President Loeffler called the December 3, 2018 regular meeting of the governing body to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the pledge to the flag. Vice-President Loeffler called for a moment of silence do to the death of George H. W. Bush, the 41<sup>st</sup> President of the US.

#### 2. APPOINT CANDIDATE FOR COUNCIL VACANCY

- a) The floor was opened for nominations, Councilman Thomas nominated Kevin Baum to be appointed to the council vacancy, Councilman Thoman seconded and the vote was taken 2-2, Councilwoman Loeffler and Vice President Loeffler voted no. Councilwoman Loeffler nominated Daniel Kauffman, Vice President Loeffler seconded and the vote was taken 2-2, Councilman Thoman and Councilman Thomas voted no. Councilman Thoman nominated Seth Rohrbaugh and there was no second, nomination was closed. Mayor Sanders was asked for his vote to break the tie for the nomination of Kevin Baum, Mayor Sanders voted no and the vote was 2-3. Mayor Sanders was asked for his vote to break the tie for the nomination of Daniel Kauffman, Mayor Sanders voted yes and the vote was 3-2. Daniel Kauffman was appointed by a 3-2 vote to the council vacancy with the term ending 12/31/19 and the remaining two years will be open for the elections that will be held at the end of 2019.
- b) The Oath of Office was given by Mayor Sanders to Daniel Kauffman.

## 3. NOVEMBER 5, 2018 MINUTES

Councilwoman Loeffler made the <u>motion</u> to approve the November 5, 2018 Minutes, Councilman Thomas seconded and the motion passed 5-0.

#### 4. PUBLIC COMMENTS

- a) John McLucas, Code Enforcement Officer was in attendance. Gave a brief report and announced that his last day as Code Enforcement Officer will be Friday, December 7.
- b) 10 Acre Property on Berlin Street Hetal Patel and her Attorney, Stacey MacNeal, were in attendance to present an idea for a Drug and Alcohol Detox Facility for the property on Berlin Street. Council agreed they would allow additional information to be presented.

#### 5. SOLICITOR'S REPORT

- a) 49 York Street Violation Councilwoman Loeffler made the **motion** to sustain Council's decision to enforce the removal of the extra width of driveway at 49 York Street, Vice President Loeffler seconded and the motion passed 4-1 with Councilman Thoman voting no. Council agreed to give 90 days to comply. Engineer Toms will check regarding PennDot's requirement for right-of-way.
- b) Property on north west corner of South Burns Road and Raber Drive Solicitor was unable to find a deed for the property. Item will be tabled for now.
- c) Ordinance No. 2018-03 (2019 Tax Rate) Councilman Thomas made the **motion** to adopt Ordinance No. 2018-03, 2019 Tax Rate, Councilwoman Loeffler seconded and the motion passed 5-0.
- d) Brokenshire Heavy Snow Removal Agreement Councilwoman Loeffler made the <u>motion</u> to approve Brokenshire Agreement, Councilman Thoman seconded and the motion passed 5-0.
- e) Solicitor Fees for the PIB Loan Council agreed to wait till the 2018 Street Project is completed before using any of the State Funds for Solicitor Fees.

- a) 2018 Street Improvements/Storm Drain Installation Councilwoman Loeffler made the <u>motion</u> to pay Application for Payment #2 from H&H Contractors, Councilman Kauffman seconded and the motion passed 5-0.
- b) Raber Drive Development The development engineer has submitted two waivers regarding the development. Borough engineer discussed what concerns may be involved in regards to the waivers. The request for the waivers will be presented to the Borough Planning Commission at their next meeting.
