### The Cannon is Missing!

Have you missed seeing the cannon? Our authentic Civil War Cannon is missing from our square for a good reason. Our cannon is in dire need of repair due to sitting on cement blocks for so many years. It has been removed by the Borough Council for restoration by a company recommended by Gettysburg Park Rangers. Protecting and restoring history is both exciting and expensive. As of 2016 Jefferson Borough will be 150 years old. In recognition of this fact, the Borough Council voted to celebrate the anniversary by restoring our cannon and placing it on a carriage to display on the square. We also have a World War I Gun which is need of repair some repair. When our fore-fathers accepted these precious artifacts, they promised to protect and care for them. The cost for the cannon repair will be \$7000. The carriage will cost another \$14,000, and the World War I Gun will be \$2800. We are asking for the help of the community to finance the restoration and protection of these important items which have been a past of our community longer than most of the citizens who currently live here. It is our hope that every family will donate \$20.00 or more so that together as a community we may work to protect and restore the history of Jefferson Borough and proudly celebrate our 150th anniversary in 2016. Contributions may be sent to Jefferson Borough identified as funds for "CANNON RESTORATION".

**SNOW REMOVAL**

Pursuant to the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 107 Part 2, § 9, Snow and Ice on Sidewalks; In the event of snowfall, the occupant or owner shall within a period of 24 hours after snowfall ceases, clear all sidewalks of snow. In the event of freezing rain or other icy conditions the occupant or owner shall spread ashes or cinders on all sidewalks within 24 hours to ensure the safety of pedestrians.

The Borough will not be placing the barrels of cinders out along the streets as we have in the past. If you have a concern or are interested in obtaining a barrel placed in a specific area within the borough please let us know and we will try to accommodate your request.
