Larry E. Baugher, 67, of Spring Grove, died Friday January 31, 2014 at York Hospital following a lengthy illness. Funeral services will be 11:00 AM Friday, February 7, 2014 at Christ United Church of Christ, 32 Baltimore Street, Codorus (Jefferson) with his pastor the Rev. Bonnie J. Whittier, officiating. Burial will follow in Jefferson Cemetery. A viewing will be held from 9:00 to 11:00 AM Wednesday at the Church. The Geiple Funeral Home, Inc., 53 Main Street, Glen Rock is handling the arrangements.

Larry was born on April 18, 1946, a son of Sarabelle L. (Cramer) Baugher of Spring Grove and the late Sterling E. Baugher.
