Larry E. Baugher, 67, of Spring

received his Masters Degree in

Employment Office of York, where
he was employed as a Labor
Market Analyst Statistician 2,
following over 30 years of

Larry had Cerebral Palsy for his
whole life and it never stopped
him from doing things that he
wanted to do. He was a generous
person who had compassion for
others, dedicated to serving many
organizations in his community
and helping others in need. He
was an active member of the
Jefferson Community Lions
Club, having served in many
leadership offices of the Club and
was a Past District Governor of
District 14-C and a Melvin Jones
Fellow of Lions Club International.
He loved to travel and his last trip
was to the Lions Club International
Convention in Hamburg Germany
this past July. He also enjoyed
boat rides on Codorus Lake.
