The following are guidelines for the safety of our Fire Policemen as well as our citizens:

- * PA Fire Police have the same authority as a Police Officer when directing traffic.
- * Title 75 Section 3102 states that no person shall willfully disobey any authorized person directing traffic.
- * Drivers have the duty to pass an emergency scene or other scene at which traffic is being directed in the opposite lane, or any area as otherwise directed by traffic control personnel.
- * If traffic is NOT being directed by anyone, drivers should pass the scene in the slowest and safest manner possible.
- * Fire Policemen have the ability to report unsafe drivers or anyone who willfully disobeys their orders to the police.
- * Failure to obey a Fire Policeman's orders can result in anywhere from a \$250 fine all the way up to suspension of a drivers license.

Keep our Fire Policemen safe, do your duty as a driver and do not drive around fire policemen, do not disobey their orders, and do not give them grief for doing their jobs. They are there to help keep you, other drivers, emergency responders, and anyone else involved in the scene safe.

TREES & VEGETATION VIOLATIONS

Residents that are in violation of Jefferson Borough Roadway Tree and Vegetation Maintenance Ordinances will receive letters to notify them that these violations need to be corrected. It is the responsibility of the owners and occupiers of any premises or property to comply with specifications set forth in the Borough Codification of Ordinances Chapters 107-Trees and Vegetation and 171-Property Maintenance, Weeds and Grass. It is required to keep all trees, shrubs, hedges and other vegetation trimmed or cut within the public right-of-way and maintain a clearance of at least **14 feet** above the roadway of any street or alley and **8 feet** above any sidewalk. BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item pick-up day is Wednesday (unless follows a holiday—see calendar above).
- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item must be curbside by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- ◆ No more than four (4) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- ◆ Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 pounds each.
- ◆ Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- ◆ No construction debris will be collected curbside.
