Unfortunately, the building of our cannon carriage has been delayed due to a variety of reasons. The delay may have been a blessing in disguise. You may have noticed, now that the winter snow has melted, we have found a rather large sink hole below the cement pad intended for the World War I gun. Previously we were forced to remove the large time capsule buried on the borough square which was located under the planned location of the World War I gun. Don't worry! The capsule was not opened and is stored in a safe place. We plan to open the time capsule during our 2016 anniversary celebration. However, the ground has given way and now must be fixed before anything else can be accomplished.

In the meantime, Pat Roser continues to sell the commemorative coin set to raise funds. Each set of the coins may be purchased for \$2.00 or three sets for \$5.00. The coins may be purchased at *Peoples Bank, Baugher Garage, Jefferson Borough Office* or through Pat Roser or Anne Loeffler. We continue to accept donations for the cost of repairing and maintaining the Cannon and World War I gun. Anyone giving donations will be listed on our borough website as a Community Supporting Member. Those who give donations of \$1000.00 or more will be listed on a permanent plaque in the borough building as Community Historians.

Now that spring has arrived, progress can begin again with the fixing of the sink hole followed by placement of our precious artifacts to their proper place for the entire community to enjoy.

Just a reminder that it is unlawful to allow or permit your dog(s) to run at large within the Borough of Jefferson. It is the duty of animal owners to keep them securely tied or penned in an enclosure in such a manner that they cannot break loose and run at large over the streets, alleys, sidewalks or public grounds in the Borough or upon the property of anyone other than the animal owner unless permission has been granted by property owner. BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item pick-up day is Wednesday (unless follows a holiday—see calendar above).
- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item must be curbed side by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- ◆ No more than four (4) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- ◆ Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 pounds each.
- ◆ Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- ◆ No construction debris will be collected curbed side.

County-wide Mosquito Surveillance Starting in York County for 2015

Residents, businesses and municipalities can greatly reduce mosquito concerns and health risk by cleaning up their own property and local community. Fourteen years of surveillance in York County indicates that the most common mosquito species in residential areas; the House Mosquito and the Asian Tiger Mosquito; are primarily produced from artificial containers left behind by humans. Artificial containers can be something small like a bottle cap to sometimes as large as a swimming pool with shallow water. Additional containers such as tires, buckets, tarps and roadside trash are preferred by mosquitoes because other predators found in nature that would prey on mosquito larvae are not present. During periods of drought these containers continue to hold water and produce mosquitoes.

York County residents are being asked to report mosquito concerns through the Pennsylvania West Nile Virus website www.westnile.state.pa.us. Doing so will better assist our program to document areas of concern.
