RESPONSIBILITY FOR REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE

ORDINANCE • ARTICLE V Chapter 151 Section 38 & 39

Every person or owner of property with a sidewalk or control of any building or lot of land shall remove and clear away or cause to be removed or cleared away snow and/or ice the entire length of the sidewalk.

No person shall be permitted to shovel, blow, plow or otherwise deposit snow and/or ice onto any street after the street has been plowed, and no person shall shovel, blow, plow, or otherwise deposit or cause to be deposited snow and/or ice upon, against or adjacent to any fire hydrant so that said deposit would prevent or obstruct access to the fire hydrant.

The Jefferson Volunteer Fire Company is asking for our help when we have a snow fall. If you live by a fire hydrant please clear the snow away from the hydrant so your emergency personnel will be able to locate the hydrant if needed.

Delayed Collection Due to Holiday

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item pick-up day is Wednesday (unless follows a holiday—see calendar above).
- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item must be curb side by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- ◆ No more than four (4) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- ◆ Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 pounds each.
- ◆ Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- ◆ No construction debris will be collected curb side.
- ◆ **Refuse rates will increase starting January 1, 2016. Quarterly Flat Billing will be \$54.75, Per Bag—26 bags minimum (\$4.25 x 26) = \$110.50, Each additional bag is \$4.25.**

Due to our geology, radon is found everywhere in Pennsylvania. For that reason, you are urged to test your homes to protect you and your family's health. Winter is the best time to test your home for radon because doors and windows are typically closed and tightly sealed, producing the most accurate results. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency sets the "action level" for radon at 4 picocuries per liter (pCi/L) of air. Residents with levels at or above that figure should take steps to lower them. IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

Due to problems created by the Pennsylvania State Law (Act 108) that requires the recycling of electronics, the York County Solid Waste Authority is forced to suspend Electronics Recycling in York County until further notice. The suspension also applies to municipal satellite programs previously conducted.

Act 108 has created an imbalance of supply and demand which makes it economically prohibitive for electronics recycling vendors to operate in Pennsylvania. This situation has been happening across Pennsylvania and has resulted in many Pennsylvania counties discontinuing their electronics recycling programs. The Authority had secured an electronics recycler for 2016, but on December 17, 2015 they informed the authority that they would not be able to service the program.

Residents and businesses should hold on to electronic devices until a new program can be implemented. The authority is working on a sustainable solution to address the proper management of electronics waste. Specific electronics waste currently banned from Pennsylvania waste disposal facilities include: televisions, desktop and laptop computers, computer monitors and computer peripherals (anything that connects to a computer such as a mouse, keyboard, printer, etc.).

Act 108 needs to change. PLEASE voice your concerns by contacting the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection at 717-787-7382 and your state legislative representatives.
