Delayed Collection Due to Holiday

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item pick-up day is Wednesday (unless follows a holiday—see calendar above).
- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item must be curbed side by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- ◆ No more than four (4) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- ◆ Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 pounds each.
- ◆ Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- ◆ No construction debris will be collected curbed side.
- ◆ **Refuse rates will increase starting January 1, 2017. Quarterly Flat Billing will be \$56.25, Per Bag—26 bags minimum (\$4.50 x 26) = \$117.00, each additional bag is \$4.50.**

THE YORK HOMEBUYERS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The York Homebuyer Assistance Program (YGAP) is designed to help income-eligible people to achieve one of the most important investments of their lives. You may qualify for up to \$5000 (County) or up to 8% of the sales price (City), not to exceed \$7000, to use toward down payment and closing costs.

This program is governed by Federal HUD regulations. To be eligible, you must be a first-time homebuyer or have not owned a home in the last three (3) years.

What is Storm Water?

Storm water is water from melting snow or rain that does not get soaked up into the ground. It flows off rooftops, over driveways and other paved areas, sloped lawns, and bare soil. It collects and transports salt, fertilizers, animal waste, oil and other car fluids, soap, pesticides, and a variety of other pollutants.

Storm water washes pollutants into ditches and storm sewers. Over time, the pollutants drain directly into rivers and streams without treatment.

What You Can Do to Prevent Storm Water Pollution

- Do not introduce anything other than water into drain.
- Do not wash your car in the driveway.
- Cut back on lawn and garden chemicals.
- Reduce the frequency of lawn mowing.
- Clean up after your pets.
