Delayed Collection Due to Holiday

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item pick-up day is Wednesday (unless follows a holiday—see calendar above).
- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item must be curb side by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- ◆ No more than four (4) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- ◆ Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 pounds each.
- ◆ Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- ◆ No construction debris will be collected curb side.
- ◆ **Refuse rates will increase starting January 1, 2017. Quarterly Flat Billing will be \$56.95, Per Bag—26 bags minimum (\$4.50 x 26) = \$117.00, Each additional bag is \$4.50.**
