Jefferson Community Memorial Day Service Sunday, May 25

Please join the community in honoring our fallen heroes, veterans and those currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces. The parade begins at 1:15 pm on Hanover Street and proceeds to the cemetery for the service. The speaker will be William York, a retired veteran.

The Borough recently received a new Public Protection Classification Rating. This rating is based on the capabilities of 911, York Water and the Jefferson Fire Company to respond to a fire and is on a scale of 1 (being the best) to 10 (being no fire protection). The Borough received a 4 which is down from our previous rate of 5. The fire company rating is an evaluation of its total operation:

- ◆ the amount, age and maintenance of the trucks and equipment,
- ◆ hours of training,
- ◆ number of personnel on duty,
- ◆ operational protocols.

The Fire Company officers are dedicated to providing the best emergency response with the funds available. The new rating goes into effect June 1, 2014. Please talk with your insurance representative during your next homeowner insurance renewal and make sure they are aware of the new lower rating, it may help lower your rates. A copy of the report is available to review at the Borough Office.

CANNON & WWI GUN WILL SOON BE BACK!

Thanks to a large grant from the York County Marcellus Shale Legacy Fund, the cost of refurbishing our historical artifacts has been achieved. Now we need to raise funds for the foundations which will be placed on the Square to hold the artifacts and keep them safe. We also will need additional funds to maintain the Cannon, WWI Gun and our Doughboy Statue.

In 2016 we will be celebrating our Borough's 150th anniversary. Preliminary plans include a Civil War Reenactment and events to honor our local veterans of all our country's battles. So the fund-raising continues for the Square and our 2016 Anniversary. The Borough Council will be having a yard sale to coincide with the Borough Yard Sale on May 10. All profits from the sale at 11 York Street will go towards the Fund for the Square. Please come by and make a cash donation for the Square.

Thanks again for your community support and the ongoing need towards the maintenance of our artifacts on the square.

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item pick-up day is Wednesday (unless follows a holiday—see calendar above).
- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item must be curbside by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- ◆ No more than four (4) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- ◆ Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 pounds each.
- ◆ Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- ◆ No construction debris will be collected curbside.
