THE CANNON IS STILL MISSING!

In our last newsletter we wrote about the need of repairing our cannon, buying a carriage, and repairing our WW1 Gun. We want to give you an update regarding what has occurred since our last newsletter.

The WW1 Gun has been repaired and is in storage awaiting placement on the Borough Square until spring. To help preserve our authentic artifacts, we will be preparing a cement base to better prevent deterioration. Our cannon has also been restored and awaits the carriage to be built before it can be returned to the square. The planning and work moves forward although the funding remains a concern. Rather than using tax dollars, we are hoping that our Jefferson residents and their families will voluntarily contribute to a special community fund to protect and preserve our important artifacts.

When our forefathers accepted these precious artifacts, they promised to protect and care for them. The cost for the cannon repair is \$7,000, repairing the WW1 Gun costs another \$2,800. Bids have been received for the carriage and Council has accepted the low bid to build an aluminum carriage which will last longer than a wooden carriage. The cost of the carriage is another \$13,000. The total cost of this community project is \$22,800.

It is our hope that every family will donate \$20.00 or more so that together as a community we can work to protect and restore the history of Jefferson Borough and proudly celebrate our 150th anniversary in 2016. Contributions can be sent to Jefferson Borough identified as funds for cannon restoration. Your help is greatly appreciated by all.

OBSTRUCTION OR MISUSE OF STREETS

We would like to remind everyone that you are not allowed to block Borough streets with parked vehicles per Borough Ordinance Code §151.

Section 151.1 - No person shall park a motor vehicle at any time so as to block any alley within the Borough.

Section 151.2 - Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to the provisions of this article shall, upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$600 and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than 30 days.

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item pick-up day is Wednesday (unless follows a holiday—see calendar above)
- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item must be curb side by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- ◆ No more than four (4) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- ◆ Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 pounds each.
- ◆ Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- ◆ No construction debris will be collected curb side.
