RENT-A-KID PROGRAM

The Rent-A-Kid Program, sponsored by the York County Area Agency on Aging, is an intergenerational program bringing older adults and teenagers together. York County adults 60 years of age or older who need help with various household chores, including lawn mowing, yard work, snow removal, electronics programming and other odd jobs can contact the York County Area Agency on Aging to hire a teenager in their area. The seniors are asked to reimburse the teens a minimum of \$5/hour, or a negotiated rate based on the job.

The teenagers are York County students in grades 7 through 12 or homeschooled. They must complete an application and have it signed by their parent and school guidance counselor. The teens are then entered into a regional data base. When the older adults contact the agency, they are matched electronically with teenagers in their area.

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item pick-up day is Wednesday (unless follows a holiday—see calendar above).
- ◆ Trash, Recycling, and one bulk item must be curb side by 6:00 AM on your scheduled collection day.
- ◆ No more than four (4) trash bags/cans will be collected each week.
- ◆ Bags or containers must not exceed 32 gallons or 50 pounds each.
- ◆ Call Penn Waste to schedule collection of appliances containing Freon (air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, etc.)
- ◆ No construction debris will be collected curb side.
- ◆ **2019 Quarterly Flat Billing is \$58.20, Per Bag—26 bags minimum annually (\$5.50 x 26) = \$143.00, Each additional bag is \$5.50.**
