**RESOLUTION APPOINTING A DELEGATE TO ENACT A BURN BAN IN  
JEFFERSON BOROUGH TO BE MOTIONED AT THE FOLLOWING BOROUGH  
COUNCIL MEETING**

---

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the York County Office of Emergency Management's Burn Ban Recommendation, the Borough of Jefferson shall respond by having the President of Council confer with the Jefferson Volunteer Fire Company's Fire Chief to enact a Burn Ban, and;

**WHEREAS**, the timing of such a Recommendation by the Office of Emergency Management may fall in the month between a Council meeting convening, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Jefferson wishes to keep its community safe from wild fire;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Borough of Jefferson that the President of Council as the Jefferson Borough Burn Ban Delegate has the jurisdiction to confer with the Jefferson Volunteer Fire Company's Fire Chief in response to the York County Office of Emergency Management's Burn Ban Recommendations, and to determine the need for such action in the Borough, and enact a Burn Ban immediately if needed, and present the action to Council for motion at the next month's Council Meeting, and;

**FURTHERMORE**, the dissolution of such Burn Ban shall be given only by a Council motion at a regularly scheduled monthly meeting;

**ADOPTED** this 6<sup>th</sup> day of August 2012 by the Jefferson Borough Council.
